He was elected by the Board of Governors of the State Bar of California to serve as State Bar President in 1994 – 1995. Mr. Fischbach is a member of the American Board of Trial Advocates (ABOTA). He is a past faculty member of the Hastings College of Advocacy, and was an adjunct assistant professor of law, teaching torts at San Joaquin College of Law in Fresno. He has also lectured extensively and authored articles on the subject of litigation.
